**Sec. 3793.04.** The department of alcohol and drug addiction 62008  
services shall develop, administer, and revise as necessary a 62009  
comprehensive statewide alcohol and drug addiction services plan 62010  
for the implementation of this chapter. The plan shall emphasize 62011  
abstinence from the use of alcohol and drugs of abuse as the 62012  
primary goal of alcohol and drug addiction services. The council 62013  
on alcohol and drug addiction services shall advise the department 62014  
in the development and implementation of the plan. 62015

The plan shall provide for the allocation and distribution of 62016  
~~state and federal~~ funds appropriated to the department by the 62017

drug addiction, and mental health services ~~and for distribution of~~ 62020  
~~the funds to such boards~~. The plan department shall exclude from 62021

The plan shall specify the methodology that the department 62026  
will use for determining how the funds will be allocated and 62027

The plan shall ensure that alcohol and drug addiction services of a high quality are accessible to, and responsive to the needs of, all persons, especially those who are members of underserved groups, including, but not limited to, African Americans, Hispanics, native Americans, Asians, juvenile and adult offenders, women, and persons with special services needs due to age or disability. The plan shall include a program to promote and protect the rights of those who receive services. 62034

To aid in formulating the plan and in evaluating the effectiveness and results of alcohol and drug addiction services, the department, in consultation with the department of mental health, shall establish and maintain an information system or systems. The department of alcohol and drug addiction services shall specify the information that must be provided by boards of alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services and by alcohol and drug addiction programs for inclusion in the system. The department shall not collect any personal information from the boards except as required or permitted by state or federal law for purposes related to payment, health care operations, program and service evaluation, reporting activities, research, system administration, and oversight. 62042

(B) Each board of alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services shall submit an annual report to the department of alcohol and drug addiction services specifying how the board used ~~state and federal~~ the funds allocated and distributed to the board, ~~according to the methodology the department specifies~~ under section 3793.04 of the Revised Code, for administrative functions in the year preceding the report's submission.
